Dues and Assessments

Regular Monthly Dues:

It is the Member's responsibility to maintain their Dues payments.

It is the Member's responsibility to report a change in contact information to the Local Union Office.

Dues are considered "on time" if paid on or prior to the 10th of the month in which they are due.

Local 60 will pay the Regular Monthly Dues of those individuals who are working under the Collective Bargaining Agreement (minimum of 140 hours monthly); provided the appropriate working assessments, are current on their dues and are not more than 4 Death Benefits in arrears.

If a Member does not receive a yellow Dues Ticket with their monthly newsletter, their dues have not been paid.
