JOBS REPORT

We have been informed the work situation looks positive for the remainder of the year, with the contractors saying manpower will be needed throughout the year. Please call the hall and stay informed with the work situation, keep in mind Local 60 is still in need of Electricians and Apprentices in the coming months.

CTHBP

A net income of \$164,000.00 for May 2018 was reported. The fund currently has \$11,851,180.00 in total net assets. Next meeting is scheduled for Sept, 2018.

Local 60 Pension /401 (k):

Local 60 Pension Plan thru May of 2018 has net assets of \$59,299,098.00 and the Local 60 401(k) Plan has total net assets of \$19,800,000.00 as of current. The 401(k) employer contributions increased 1% June 1, 2018, from 4% to 5%.

Local 60 Dues Structure

When paying your union dues (currently \$38.00 a month), the PBF (international pension), International Death Benefit and participation in the Local Death Fund are all part of the benefits, approximately (\$20,000.00). Dues are due on or before the 10th of the current month for 2018) so that you are eligible for these benefits.
