CTHBP

A deficit of \$310,000.00 for June 2018 was reported. The fund currently has \$11,102,000.00 in total net assets. Next meeting is scheduled for Sept, 2018.

Local 60 Pension /401 (k):

Local 60 Pension Plan thru May of 2018 has net assets of \$59,468,050.00 and the Local 60 401(k) Plan has total net assets of \$20,100,000.00 as of current. The 401(k) employer contributions increased 1% June 1, 2018, from 4% to 5%.
