In accordance with Constitution per the 39th International Convention in 2016, the dues amount will increase \$1.00, effective January 2019.

\$19 to I.O. for Monthly Dues  
\$19 Pension Benefit Fund or PBF  
\$.50 IBEW Local 60 dues  
\$.50 for the Local 60 Sick Fund  
**\$39.00 Total Monthly Dues**

The PBF (I.O. pension) pays \$4.50  
Per credited year (ex. 20yrs X 4.5 = \$90)

Monthly benefit is \$90.00

### Career Employment:

### CTHBP

A deficit of (\$274,000.00) for the month end of August 2018 was reported by the fund, currently total assets are \$10,495,028.00. The next meeting will be a special called for November 2018 to discuss the replacement of our Third Party Administrators.

### Local 60 Pension /401 (k):

The Local 60 Pension Plan thru July of 2018 has total assets of \$61,712,000.00 and the Local 60 401(k) Plan has Plan assets of \$20,200,000.00 as of current. Next scheduled meetings are January 2019.

### New Union Hall and Office Building

The Local Union 60 hall and administrative office that will be located at 3520 N.
