A deficit of \$99,000.00 for the month end of July 2018 was reported by the fund, currently total assets are \$10,875,745.46. The next meeting is scheduled for September 26, 2018.

Local 60 Pension /401 (k):

The Local 60 Pension Plan thru July of 2018 has total assets of \$60,723,000.00 and the Local 60 401(k) Plan has Plan assets of \$20,500,000.00 as of current. Next scheduled meetings are January 2019.
