We appreciate your help with all efforts.

CTHBP

The final month of the year (December) was terrible..... a deficit of (\$1,500,000.00) was reported for the fund. With that being said, the trustees (after a lengthy and heated discussion) passed a motion to increase the plans contributions (40 cents was agreed upon), with that the contractors will contribute 20 cents and Labor will contribute 20 cents (effective June 3rd 2019), the 20 cents will reflect on the JIW wage and all other classification by percentage. Local 60 Pension /401 (k):

The Local 60 Pension Plan thru January of 2019 has total assets of over \$55,600,000.00 and the Local 60 401(k) Plan has Plan assets of over \$21,200,000.00 as of current. Next scheduled meetings are May 2019.
